MÁS AMOR, 2019

Mas Roig, DO Catalunya

Más Amor or More Love echoes the livelihood of Barcelona. We deliberately choose this graffiti painted on the wall that represents the urban art of this city full of energy. The picture was taken on 14th February 2010 (St Valentine's Day). Más Amor is the expression of a rosé coming from the slopes of the Ebro river. The house where the photo was taken no longer exist, it was destroyed a few days after the picture was taken.

Origin

Village: EL Mas Roig. Vines located between 540 y 580 meters.

Grape Variety

90% Garnacha and 10% Tempranillo

Age of the vines

Between 15 and 25 years old planted on clay and sandy soil..

Technical data

Alcohol content: 14% ; Acidity: 5,40 g/l ; PH: 3,25 ; Harvest: Manual.

Care undertake on the vineyard and vinification

At the moment of the harvest, the grapes were at the good point of ripeness, keeping a good acidity and therefore, providing freshness to the wine.

Alcoholic fermentation took place in stainless steel tanks for around 2 weeks at controlled temperature.

Ageing

Maceration with the skins was carried out for 4 hours to avoid extraction of too many polyphenols and tannins. No barrel ageing.

Tasting Note

Más Amor 2019 has a marked citric aroma on the nose, lime and orange and little strawberries notes. Very light, fresh, easy-drinking on the palate, reminiscent of grapefruit and a hint of peppermint. The perfect partner for salads and fish.
